TABOR DAYS 2010 - A FUN, FAMILY-ORIENTED WEEKEND

Tabor Children's Services is going to the dogs. And cats, and other pets, that is. On Saturday, May 22, and Sunday, May 23, the child welfare agency will host its annual family festival, called Tabor Days, on the Tabor grounds at Main Street and New Britain Road in Doylestown Township. This will be the second year that the theme of Tabor Days is Pets on Parade. Proceeds from Tabor Days support the organization's work with abused and neglected children throughout southeastern Pennsylvania.

Tabor Days will take place on Saturday from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. and on Sunday from noon to 4 p.m.. Offering a variety of activities for families and their four-legged companions, the festival will feature animal demonstrations and a petting zoo from Peaceable Kingdom, pet parades and a pet awards program with celebrity judges, and adoption opportunities with local dog and cat rescue groups. Well-mannered, leashed pets are welcome.

Inflatables, children's games, a silent auction and other shopping opportunities, food, and a flowering plant sale will round out the activities at Tabor Days. Admission is \$5 per person and \$10 for families, with a \$3 surcharge for those enjoying the inflatables.

On Sunday an antiques appraisal booth will be open throughout the afternoon, with appraisals conducted by Joe Laskowski of Griffin's Gallery of Fine Art in Phoenixville. Appraisal fees are \$5 per item or three items for \$12.

Both days will include a full schedule of live entertainment including the Mummers' Uptown String Band, oldies band Blast from the Past, Scottish bagpipe band Cairngorm Pipes & Drums, folk singers Pour Rabbits, the Doylestown Heat Big Band, and much more. A highlight of each afternoon will be a pet parade and awards in fun and creative categories.

Harkening back to a venerable tradition of holding a May Day fundraiser during the early and mid-20th century, when children lived at the former Tabor Home, the 2010 Tabor Days will include a Tabor Alumni bake sale. In addition, Tabor trustee, alumnus and author Orville Wright Jr. will be on hand to sign and selling the book, "'Twas A Hard Knock Life: The Tabor

Home Story."

Tabor Days Pets on Parade not only offers the community a great weekend of fun activities for families (with and without pets), but also provides opportunities to share information about the services through which Tabor helps needy children and families in our area. All proceeds from this annual fun family festival benefit Tabor's work with abused and neglected children.
